

11. *This job is a routine work. What would motivate you to do it well every day?*

Hint: Jobs in retail stores are repetitive. Therefore you should **focus on your preference of routine jobs**. Not everyone needs new challenges every day. As an ideal applicant for a job in retail, you should prefer routine. A good feeling from a well-done job can also resonate in your answer to this interview question.

Alternatively you can say that from your point of view **none job is repetitive, if one has the right mindset**.

Good answers:

- To be honest with you, I prefer routine to creativity. Once I learn to do the job, I do it well and feel good in work. Jobs in which you have to learn new things every day are not a good choice for me.

- From my point of view, this job is not repetitive. I know that cashiers (laborers, stockers, sales associates, etc.) carry out the same tasks day every day. But there are problems you need to solve and new clients you talk to every day. Many different things happen in a store on a daily basis. From my point of view, this job is fun to do, not a boring one. Some tasks may be routine, but it doesn't make the job boring.

- Relationships matter the most for me. If I enjoy time spent with my colleagues, if I feel like a member of a hard-working team, it makes me happy and motivated to work hard all the time. It does not matter if the job is repetitive, or not.
